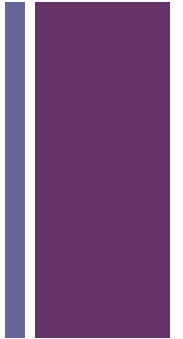
Key Action 1: Individual
mobility

+ Eligible: 34 countries

- 28 EU member states
- Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, FYROM

Partner countries:

- Divided into different regions
 - E.g. Region 1/ Western Balkans: Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, Serbia
 - Possibility if participating in certain actions/ subject to certain conditions (will be defined in the Programme Guide)





What's new for Key Action 1: Learning Mobility of Individuals



Partially changed target groups/ modalities compared to the LLP:

- Institutional approach for all kinds of mobility in KA1
- Study visits programme for education and vocational training specialistis and decision makers: Will not be continued this way (maybe only for school leaders)
- In-service training for education staff: only institutions (i.e. schools) can apply

+ In-service training

Institutional approach

- Applications of schools instead of applications of individuals
- “European Development Plan” as part of the application (thoughts and objectives for the school’s training/ about sensible preparation and follow-up)

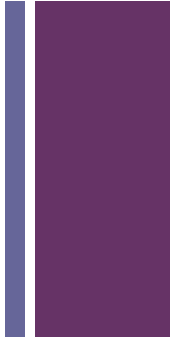




European Development Plan



- **Organisation (School) needs for training** (i.e. management competences, staff competences, new teaching methods and tools, European dimension, language competences, curriculum, organisation of teaching and learning)
- **The plans of the organisation (school)** for European mobility and cooperation activities and how these will contribute to meeting the identified needs.
- How will your organisation (school) integrate the competences and experiences acquired during the training into its **strategic development** in the future?



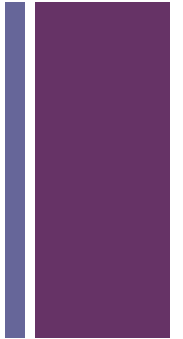
- One single application per institution for all planned training activities abroad during a specific period (selectively for 1 or 2 years)
 - Names and specific dates do not have to be listed in the application
 - One application date per year

March 17, 2014

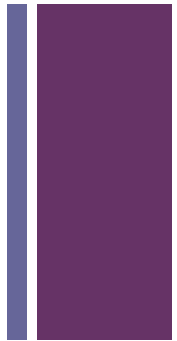
Earliest date of training course: 1/7/2014

+ Funding

Eligible costs	Financing mechanism	Amount
Costs directly linked to payment of <u>fees</u> or enrolment in courses	Unit costs	70 EUR per participant per day. Maximum of 700 EUR per participant in the mobility project
Organisational support including preparation (pedagogical, intercultural, linguistic), monitoring and support for participants during mobility, validation & learning outcomes- <u>excluding</u> <u>substinence</u>	Unit costs	Up to the 100 th participant: 350 EUR per participant + beyond the 100 th participant: 200 EUR per additional participant.



+ Funding

Eligible costs	Financing mechanism	Amount
Individual support= Subsistence of participants during the activity	Unit costs	50-160 EUR per day up to the 14th day depending on the receiving country. Exact amounts will be published on the National Agencies' websites- Between 15 th & 60 th day of activity 70% of this amount per participant per day
Travel costs	Unit cost	Varying from (starting from 180/ participant) depending on the distance
Special needs: additional costs related to participants with disabilities	Portion of eligible costs	100% of eligible costs

+ Award criteria for schools' applications

- Relevance of the proposal (max: 30 points)
- Quality of the proposal design and implementation (max: 30 points)
- Impact and dissemination (max: 30 points)

To be considered for funding school proposals must score at least 60 points consisting of at least half of the points in each category.
